



Annual Art Contest

The 2018 Arizona Problem Solving Court Conference includes the 4th annual art contest open to current or past problem solving court participants. Conference attendees will vote on their favorite entry at the conference and the top three winners will receive gift cards (1st place = \$100, 2nd place = \$75 and 3rd place = \$50).

The guidelines for the contest:

1. Each problem solving court in your county can enter up to 5 art pieces (entries can be paintings, drawings, sculptures, poems)
2. Each problem solving court is responsible for vetting the art entries prior to submission and obtaining the artists' permission to display and photograph their art and name (see page 2 for Release of Information)
3. Each entry is to align with the conference theme (Heroes Unite for Justice), or with Recovery
4. Each program designee will bring the art entries to the conference for display (we will have a designated area) and will be responsible for taking the art entries back to their county after the conference ends
5. The deadline for submissions is April 2nd, 6 p.m.
6. Once you have identified your entries, send the following to our AADCP Secretary, Robin Hoskins at Robin.Hoskins@asu.edu
 - Photo of art entry
 - Name of Problem Solving Court and County
 - Name of Artist (current or past participant in your program), plus a **brief** (200 words or less) bio/history of the artist.
 - Description of how the art entry aligns with the conference theme or recovery (250 words or less)
 - Name and contact information of point person (staff) in your program that will be attending the conference and responsible for the art work
 - Late submissions will not be accepted
